<b>Question 1</b>	What options does an approved provider have in regards to increasing cost rates?	<b>Asked By:</b>	Jamie Dunn
<b>Response:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In order to increase the rate a provider may submit an amendment to their contract which is subject to the approval of MSDE. By amendment, the provider must adhere to the Consumer Price Index (CPI). MSDE's Procurement Officer, Mr. Alan Delman can be of further assistance in this matter.</li> <li>• Another option for an approved provider wishing to increase their rates, is to submit a reapplication during the application period for potential offerors which occurs once per year.</li> <li>• Approved Providers interested in submitting a reapplication should contact Robert Reichert at 410-767-0281 or email <a href="mailto:reichert@msde.state.md.us">reichert@msde.state.md.us</a>, to request that their organization be added to the mailing list for notification of future Request for Qualifying Providers (RFQ) releases.</li> </ul>
